### 5.1 UASIDEKICK APP BY JOHHY YASSEMEDIS

(as posted on Facebook)


"Here is a link to the free software the AMA offers to our members. There is monthly fee for none members. It is used to find out if you are in controlled airspace, and a simple click method to get FAA authorization. This enables the ability fly legally off an AMA charter club site. As always please make sure you have permission to fly from the landowner! In the future a small transponder will be required of a FRIA site that has not been developed yet. So just fly safety as you have without one.

#### 5.2 CIRCLE CHECK – PAUL SULLIVAN

I don't know how many times I've come to the field and found items that folks have left behind. It may be a glow starter, a battery checker, or more often, a frequency pin.

It's easy to become a bit distracted while we're getting ready to leave because we're saying our goodbys, and our minds are shifting to going home. The idea of a "Circle Check" is to actually walk a circle around the area including the frequency post as well as the gazebo before you leave for the day. Take a minute to do this, and make it a habit.

#### 5.3 BNF AIRPLANE WITH FLAPS – JOHN YASSEMEDIS

Here's a on-the-fly list I just whipped up for new instructor with a new BNF airplane with flaps.

Set up new model.

Name the model xxxxx.

Set wing type.

Set up dual elevator, aileron, rudder rates on 3 switches 100, 85, 60% can be set per book but I start here.

Add 30% expo all 9 switch settings 65% for a 3D airplane.

Set throttle kill switch, and verify kill with monitor screen.

Set flaps-to-elevator mix.

Slow flap speed to 3 sec.

Set Flight Modes to ON and assigned to flap switch.

Swap Elevator trim from Common to Flight Mode.

Set audio switch change reports on each rate position switch, flaps & kill (this takes a while with DX and NX series radio) use high rates elevator in center and know rates on the bottom. Repeat with aileron and rudder.

Set timer to 5 min and start and stop to silent (default timer start, timer stop is annoying).

Put switches to high rates and

Bind with bind plug out.

Test direction and reverse if needed.

Assign SAFE to a switch with sticks in and down then rocking the gear channel 5 times fast.

Check and set control surfaces to level with mechanical adjustments and then sub trim.

Throttle half way and down and test AS3X.

Perform range check.

Test fly and trim, remember each flap setting elevator is trimmed again because elevator trim is independent for each mode.

\*Set up gains if you're doing plug-n-play (PNP) airplane vs bind-n-fly (BNF) and using a new Forward Programming RX. All down following the on-screen menu.


